### 1-The Bible conflicts with the stages of natural childbirth in obstetrics and gynecology

In it, the Bible describes for us in the thirty-eighth chapter, and in paragraphs 27 through paragraph 30 of the same chapter, the moment of Tamar's birth after she became pregnant by Judah, her father-in-law, the father of her two previous husbands, Er and Onan, who died without Tamar becoming pregnant by them, which made Judah fear that he would marry her to his third son, Shelah, the brother. The third brother is theirs, for fear that he will die like his brothers. We are not now in the process of tracing how Tamar became pregnant by her father-in-law, even though he is forbidden from having intercourse with his sons' wife, and his relationship with her is one of incest. Oh, obstetricians and gynecologists

It is known to doctors that the exit of the fetus from the uterus during the birth process requires successive contractions of the uterus, which are called labor or labor.

This labor, which occurs at a certain rate, is slow at first, causing the cervix to dilate, which is the first stage of childbirth

This is followed by an increase in the rate and strength of contractions, which causes an increase in uterine pressure, which pushes the fetus through the birth canal to the outside. Then the third stage, during which the placenta is separated from the uterine wall to push it outside the uterus. After that, the uterus contracts on itself to stop the blood supply to the uterine wall to prevent fatal bleeding. For hemoptysis after the delivery of the baby and the placenta

It is scientifically known to obstetricians and gynecologists that the position of the fetus during birth varies. The fetus may come in the head position,

or it may come in the breech position, or it may come in the shoulder or arm position. This refers to the first part that passes through the birth canal.

It is also known that the easiest position for childbirth is the head position, followed by the breech position, then the shoulder or arm position, which is considered the most difficult position and may cause the death of the mother if she is not informed by the skilled doctor who should give her a cesarean section to save the mother and the child, since as soon as a part of the child appears from the Inside the birth canal, the intense pressure inside the uterus quickly pushes the rest of the baby out and birth occurs

But the Bible depicts to us that the midwife who was giving birth to Tamar discovered that Tamar was pregnant with twins, and we do not know how she knew. Did they have ultrasound machines or magnetic resonance imaging? Then, when one of the twins took his arm out, I did not try to pull the fetus out or put his arm back in. Rather, all I did was bring a red scarlet ribbon and tie it to the baby's arm, which quickly pulled his arm into the womb again and then moved back to give the other twin the opportunity to go ahead of him in the birth. Was there a preference for whoever was born first, and did the midwife know in advance that the first twin would pull his arm in, so she wanted to distinguish him with a scarlet ribbon from his brother, without knowing that it was a twin?

Does this agree with your modern knowledge, O doctors, or is it an attempt to make Pharez take precedence over Zerah, considering the idea of birthright, which gives the first child a blessing over the second child, even if it is one of the twins? So, Pharez is the grandfather of David the Prophet, as people claim.

Is it possible for this to be said to be a miracle? We know that Tamar's pregnancy was the result of an incestuous woman, as she became pregnant by her fatherin-law, her husband's father. Can miracles happen to prostitutes, and is it permissible for us to attribute

### 2- Is birth control in sheep and goats a scientific fact or a myth?

When Jacob objected to Laban deceiving him, Laban said to him, "You must work as a servant for me for another seven years so that it will be Rachel's dowry." Jacob accepted and worked for another seven years, which is Rachel's dowry, and we are not now in the process of investigating the story But let's look at Jacob's wages after he completed his term and began to take his wives and wages for his work for fourteen years of service, and lo and behold, Balaban refused to give him his wages and told him, "You want to take the sheep and goats and steal my money." Finally, they agreed that everything that is born is black or speckled, that is, has spots. Black will be Jacob's, and everything that is born white will belong to Laban, the Armenian, Jacob's son-in-law. It happened that Jacob pulled out a great trick to seize Laban's sheep. So Laban isolated all the black sheep and goats, and the Balqa was far away from the rest of the sheep,

leaving him with only the white ones. So Jacob cut down a large number of the trunks of almond, milk, and plane trees. Then he peeled the bark of these logs so that they had white lines on them, which had exposed bark, and dark lines, which were not stripped of the bark, and he set them near the sheep pastures so that the flocks of sheep and goats could look at them while drinking and conceive, and behold, all the sheep and goats gave birth to speckled sheep and goats because of the process of conceiving, which Jacob understood more than five years ago. A thousand years, who would say these words, oh wise people? Do animals have births, and does the birth change the composition of the genetic tape, resulting in a generation of spotted goats and sheep just because they looked at the bark of tree trunks? Is this God's revelation?

And he said: Determine your wages for me, and I will give them to you. So he said to him: You know what I have served you for, and what your livestock have become with me, because what you had before me was little has increased to much, and the Lord has blessed you in my wake. Now when I also work for my house, he said: What shall I give you? Jacob said: Don't give me anything. If you do this for me, I will again feed your sheep and keep them. I will pass through all your flocks

Today, remove from it every spotted and spotted sheep, and every black sheep among the sheep, and every spotted and spotted sheep among the goats. And my reward shall be like this, and my righteousness shall be witnessed on the morrow, when I come before you for my reward. Everything that is not speckled or speckled among the goats and black among the sheep is stolen from me. Then Laban said, "Behold, let it be according to your word." So he separated on that day the male goats that were speckled and spotted, and all the female goats that were speckled and spotted, all that were white and all that were black among the sheep.

And he gave it into the hands of his sons, and made three days' journey between him and Jacob. And Jacob was pasturing Laban's remaining sheep. So Jacob took for himself green rods of laban, almonds, and plane trees, and peeled the white streaks on them, scraping off the white that was on the rods, and he hung the rods that he had peeled in the cisterns by the water courses where they were. The sheep come to drink, towards the sheep, to conceive when they come to drink. So the sheep conceived at the bars, and the sheep gave birth to stripes, specks, and specks. Then Jacob separated the lambs and made the faces of the sheep to the stripes, and all the lions among Laban's sheep. And he made flocks for himself alone and did not put them with Laban's flocks. And it happened that whenever the stronger sheep conceived, Jacob put the bars in front of the eyes of the sheep in the pits so

that they could conceive between the bars. And when the sheep became weak, he did not put them, so the weak ones became Laban's and the strong ones belonged to Jacob, so the man expanded very greatly, and he had many sheep, female servants, menservants, camels, and donkeys.

#### 3- Questions for venereologists and andrologists

Is it possible for a drunk man, under the influence of alcohol and in the complete absence of consciousness, to have an erection and be able to penetrate and ejaculate, and even achieve complete ejaculation that leads to fertilization?

tonight. He also did not know whether she was lying down or when she was standing up. Then the conclusion comes that Lot's daughters became pregnant by their father. Who acknowledges this statement, oh masculine scholars? Is this consistent with science or is it considered imagination? Is this considered a miracle that happens with the prophets? Is it like? # 9-How do you judge? If the birthright had any merit in the law of the children of Israel Why did you ignore it when looking at the birth of Ishmael and Isaac, the two sons of Abraham?

It is a strange matter that requires only a pause. He went in, closed the door, and prayed to the Lord. Then he went up and lay on top of the boy, and put his mouth on the boy's mouth, his eyes on his eyes, and his hands on his hands. And whoever carries them shall wash his clothes and bathe himself in water, and be unclean until the evening. And everyone The one with the affliction touched him, and he did not wash his hands with water. He shall wash his clothes and bathe himself in water, and be unclean until the evening. And the earthen vessel that the afflicted person touched Not to be broken. Every wooden vessel must be washed with water, and when the one with the issue is cleansed of its issue, seven days are counted for it to purify it, and he washes his clothes and bathes his body. With living water, he will be cleansed

#### 15-All human society is impure according to the laws of the Bible

And if it is a woman, her blood flows for many days other than the time of her menstruation, or if it flows after Her impurity, so all the days of the issue of her impurity shall be as in the days of her impurity. She is unclean. Every bed on which she lies all the days of her issue shall be to her as the bed of her impurity. And all the furniture on which she sits shall be unclean, according to the impurity of her menstrual impurity. And whoever touches them shall be unclean. He shall wash his clothes and bathe himself in water, and She will be unclean until the evening, and when she is clean from her discharge, she will be considered for herself for seven days and then she will be clean.

### 16-Another question for obstetricians and gynecologists: Is there a difference in the postpartum period when giving birth to a male or female?

Then she shall remain for sixty-six days in the blood of her purification, and when the days of her purification for a son or a daughter are completed, she shall bring a lamb of the first year as a burnt offering, and A young pigeon or a turtledove for a sin offering to the door of the tabernacle of meeting, to the priest. He shall present them before the Lord and make atonement for them, and they shall be cleansed from the And her blood. This is the law of a woman who gives birth to a male or female

### 17-The strangest dowry in human history was not offered by the groom or his family, but by the entire village

One of the strangest stories in the history of mankind, which is not accepted by law, reason, or custom, is the story of the marriage of Shechem, son of Hamu the Horite, the ruler of the earth, during the time of the life of the Prophet of God, Jacob. ### 19-A question for astronomers: Can astrologers be led by a star in the sky of Persia until it reaches Jerusalem?

She does not apologize for not getting up to hide what she stole from her father's idols. O people of reason, was Jacob the son-in-law of a polytheist man, and did Jacob's wives worship idols? Is it appropriate for Jacob to have a relationship with his son-in-law, Laban the Armenian, who is actually his uncle? And Jacob's wives, Rachel and Leah, are his cousins. Is it reasonable for their relationship to be like this

Then Jacob arose, and loaded his children and his wives on the camels, and led away all his livestock and all his possessions that he had acquired: his possessions, which he had acquired in He condemned the Syrians, to bring his father Isaac to the land of Canaan. But Laban had gone to shear his sheep, so Rachel stole her father's idols and deceived Jacob overthrew Laban the Aramean Because he did not tell him that he was fleeing, he fled, he and all that he had, and he arose and crossed the river and set his face toward Mount Gilead. to Laban the Aramean in a dream at night And he said to him, "Be careful that you speak neither good nor evil to Jacob." So Laban pursued Jacob, and Jacob pitched his tent in the mountain. So Laban struck with his brothers in Mount Gilead. And Laban said to Jacob, "What have you done? That you have deceived me, and taken my daughters as captives to the sword?" Why did he flee? Did you come in secret and deceive me and did not tell me so that I might send you off with joy and songs, with the tambourine and the lyre, and you did not let me kiss my sons and my daughters? Now through foolishness I have done it in the power of mine hand to do you evil; but the God of your father spoke to me last night, saying, Take heed that you speak neither good nor bad to Jacob. Evil and now you are gone because you longed for your father's house, but why did you steal my gods? Then Jacob answered and said to Laban, "I was afraid, because I said, 'Perhaps you will take your two daughters by force by me. The one with whom you find your gods will not live. In front of our brothers, see what I have and take it for yourself." Jacob did not know that Rachel had stolen it.

So Laban entered Jacob's tent, Leah's tent, and the two maids' tents, but he did not find them. He left Leah's tent and entered Rachel's tent. Rachel had taken the idols and placed them on the camel's wheels and sat on them. Then Laban searched for all the tents but did not find anything. Then she said to her father, "Do not be angry, my lord, because I cannot stand before you, because I have the custom of women." So he searched and did not find the idols, so Jacob became angry and quarreled with Laban. Then Jacob answered and said to Laban, "What is my crime? What have I sinned that you have defended me? You spied all my furniture. What did you find of all the furniture in your house? Place it here in front of my brothers and yours, so let them do justice between us two.

### 27- Incidents of incest within the texts of the Bible.

Who believes in them and what is the purpose of mentioning them?

What is the purpose of having five cases of adultery - not ordinary adultery, but incest - as adulterers are not just human devils, but prophets and their sons with the women and daughters of their families!!!!!! .. how ??

It is not permissible to marry them, let alone fornicate with them, but God has made mahrams among women And do not marry the women your fathers married, except those which have already been married. Indeed, that is an immorality, an abomination, and an evil path.

The first case: A prophet committed incest with his two daughters, having sex with each of them one night They become pregnant by him and give birth to two children, the result of incest between the father and his two daughters. It is between Lot, the Jesuit, and his two daughters. I spoke about it in detail before, which came in the Book of Genesis (19:30-38) as follows: Lot was afraid to live in Zoar, so he went up the mountain and stayed in the cave with his two daughters. The eldest said to the younger, "Our father is old, and there is no man on the land who will marry us according to the custom of all the people of the land. Come, let us make our father drink wine, and we will lie with him and raise up descendants from our father." So they made their father drink wine that night, and the eldest came and slept with her father while he did not know whether she was asleep or awake. The next day, the eldest said to the younger: "Yesterday I slept with my father, so let us make him drink wine tonight as well, and you can lie with him so that we may raise up offspring from our father." So they made their father drink wine that night as well, and the younger one got up and slept with him while he did not know whether she was sleeping or waking up. So Lot's daughters became pregnant from their father, and the eldest bore a son and named him Moab, and he is the father of the Moabites to this day. The youngest also bore a son and named him Ben Ammi, and he is the father of the children of Ammon to this da

The second case: The son of a prophet commits incest with his father's wife, who is forbidden to him just as his mother is forbidden, so he has intercourse with her. It is between Reuben, the eldest and firstborn son of the Prophet Jacob (the Jesuit), and his father's concubine (Bilhah) and what is forbidden to him is like the prohibition of his mother - not only that - but also the mother of his two brothers from his father, namely (Dan) and (Naptali). Your Holy Book narrates it in the Book of Genesis (35: 21-22) as follows Then Jacob departed from there and pitched his tent on the other side of Migdol Eder, and while he lived in that land,

Reuben went and slept with Bilhah, his father's concubine, and Jacob heard about it. "..and the question here: Is this Reuben, the firstborn son of Jacob the Prophet, who your Holy Book mentioned was that he wrestled with God, so He gave him the blessing according to what was stated in the Book of Genesis (32: 23-33)?? Is this God's blessing?? .. Where is the blessing that God gave him so that his eldest son committed incest with his wife and the mother of his two sons?? Why did the Bible not mention anything about what Jacob the Prophet did with his adulterous son, his eldest son, in revenge for his honor, the honor of his two sons, and the honor of his wife after he learned what had happened?? Why did the Bible not mention what Jacob's sons Dan and Naphtali did with Reuben, their older brother, who raped their mother and stepmother?? What is the benefit of mentioning this vile story without any lesson or deterrent result for this obscene immorality, and leaving the ending open like this??

The third case: The son of a Prophet commits adultery with his son's wife, who is forbidden to him, just as his daughter is forbidden, and he has intercourse with her It seems that our master Jacob, peace be upon him, was afflicted by the Bible in his children with incest. Here is the Bible, after mentioning to us the story of the adultery of Reuben, Jacob's eldest son. Here we find it mentioning the story of incest between Judah, Jacob's fourth son, with his son Tamar's wife, as its details are mentioned in the Bible. In the Book of Genesis (38:13-18) as follows: "And it was said to Tamar, 'Behold, your father-in-law is going up to Timnath to shear his sheep.' She did this because she saw that Shelah, the son of Judah, had grown up, and she had not married him. Judah saw her and considered her an adulteress because she was covering her face. So he decided." To her on the way, he said to her: Come, I will come in to you. He did not know that she was his daughter-in-law. She said, What will you give me until you come in to me? He said: I will send you a young kid. She said: Give me a mortgage until you send it. He said: What mortgage shall I give you? She said: Your ring, your turban, and your staff that With your hand, he gave it to her and entered upon her, and she became pregnant from him. Thank you. The pornographic story ended

The fourth case: The son of a prophet committed incest and raped his sister, who was forbidden to him from incest, despite her pleas to him. Just as the Bible afflicted the Prophet Jacob with his children due to incest, King David the Prophet

also had a share of this affliction. And you, won't you be like one of the fools in Israel? Speak to the king, for he will not withhold me from you. He refused to listen to her words, so he attacked her and raped her. I think that this foolish story does not need comment, but what really needs comment is what was mentioned in the same book about the reaction of David the prophet, Tamar's father, and Absalom, the son of David, Tamar's brother. The following was mentioned in the second book of Samuel. King David heard everything that happened and became very angry, but he did not He wanted to harm Amnon because he loved him, but as for Absalom, he did not speak evil or good to Amnon, because he hated him because he raped his sister. The Holy Bible tells us that King David the Prophet did not punish his son Amnon for this act because he was... He loves him.. How fair the Bible tells us that Absalom did not speak well or harm to Amnon because he hated him for raping his sister.. (meaning, he argued with him and was upset with him)

The fifth case: The son of a Prophet commits incest with his father's wives and his concubines, which are forbidden to him just as his mother was forbidden. Just as the Bible mentioned that two sons of Jacob had committed incest, justice required it to also mention two sons of David who had also committed incest. After the story of Amnon and Tamar, we find Absalom, son of David, also practicing forbidden sexual intercourse with his father's concubines, as stated in the Book of Samuel. The second (16: 21-22) is as follows: Then Ahithophel said to him: "Go in to your father's maids whom he left to take care of the palace, so that all the children of Israel will hear that you have become hated by your father." Then the resolve of all who were with you was strengthened, so I pitched a tent for Absalom on the roof, and he went in to his father's maids, in sight of the children of Israel. Ahithophel's advice was in Those days were as if they were from God. They were for Absalom, as they were for David. Thank you. The comic story has ended.

#### **Conclusion**

And even though we believe in the revelation of these books as a whole, it is our Lord, Blessed and Most High, who informed us of their revelation, as the Almighty said: Indeed, We sent down the Torah, in which is guidance and light. The prophets judge by it those who have submitted to those They and the Rabbis and the Rabbis were guided by what they had memorized of the Book of God. And they were witnesses over him. And God Almighty said, "And We left in their footsteps Jesus, son of Mary, confirming what was before him of the Torah. And We gave him the Gospel in it guidance." And a light, and confirming what is before Him of the Torah, and a guidance and an admonition for the righteous.) And as He also said, "And We favored some of the prophets over others, and We gave David a Psalm." But we do not believe in everything that is found in it now, which human hands have introduced to erase the signs of monotheism, attribute vice to the righteous prophets of God, and tamper with heavenly laws that have made them an object of contempt by those with sound minds, even if they are not of the faith of monotheism, which has made these texts a source of ridicule and no respect from these atheists. Those who constitute the non-religious community. Therefore, through these pages, I wanted to exonerate the divine revelation from this absurdity and prove that God's revelation does not conflict with science and sound reason, as it is a revelation from a wise and praiseworthy person. Whenever there is a text from the texts of these holy books that opposes science, you must accuse these writers of it. And do not detract from the revelation of the Lord of the Worlds, and wherever you find a text in the final revelation of God that was revealed to the Seal of the Prophets and Messengers, beware of accusing the text and you must review the knowledge of these hadith scholars, for the revelation of God is established and preserved with the words of God Almighty. Indeed, it is we who have sent down the Remembrance, and indeed we will preserve it, an innocence that we declare to our Creator.
